1. Organizers:

Polish Reservist Association Of Wielkopolska with co-operation of Tarnowo Podgorne,
Wielkopolska's Military Gendarmerie in Poznan Unit, Training Center "La Costa" in Lusowo,
General Jozef Dowbor Musnicki Museum.

2. Date of the Competition: 25.02.2012 (saturday)

Hours: from 9:00 to 15:00.

3. Place of Competition: Lusowo (near Poznan), Barracs CSWL- Poznan

4. Principle of participation:

This competition is a team event. Each team consists of four competitors. The maximum number of teams is 30 (in order to take part in the Competition the application moment is crucial). The right to start in Competition have:

- The adults having proof of identity (for e.g. ID Cards, passports) which they must submit during verification process at the Competition Organizers Office or
- The Youth if the team's captain is of age.

Each of the competitor must sign the Application Card confirming the Contestant's health conditions allow him/her to attend the Competition, that he/she is familiar with the Competition regulations and he/she commits on complying with them. Furthermore the Contestant agrees that the Organizers will process their personal data for the qualification purpose.

Written applications consisting of: name of the team, place which that team represents, names of the Contestants, their birth dates and the ID card numbers/ passport numbers, please send to:

5. The Competition Program:

- Meeting Military Patrol - march (distance: 8 km depending on the age of Contestants).
- MILITARY MULTISHOOTING

Classification open and special for foreigners

DETAILS ABOUT COMPETITION IN MULTISHOOTING :

- **Machine gun „Kalashnikov”** - 12 shots, auto mode, distance 100m, time 1 minute
- **Military Pistol TT (Tokariew)** caliber 7,62 - 10 shots, distance 25m, time 1 minute,
- **Machine pistol „Glauberyt”**-10 shots, distance 50m, time 1 minute
- **Machine pistol „Pepesza - 42”**-10 shots, distance 50m, time 1 minute

The map with detailed march routes will be distributed on the day of the Competition.

Notice: The route mostly runs through one of the most beautiful historic regions of Tarnowo Podgorne and Lusowo Lake. Along the route there will be a lot of surprising hidden traps

(discharging minefield, overcoming the survival village, first aid, shooting from a sports weapon, shooting with a bow and arrows, throwing a grenade, a helmet, breaking down and assembling military weapon, camouflaging, estimating distances, knowledge of military ranks, of Polish Armed Forces, covering water jumps, driving Quad vehicle and an off-road vehicle, etc.

The last Competition stop is at General Jozef Dowbor Musnicki Museum where the finishing line will be set.

Time Schedule : 25.02.2012

8:30 - 8.45 - Verification process of all the Contestants.

8.45 - Teams rally.

9:00 - Ceremonial opening, firing a salvo by the Historic Group Officer from the Wielkopolska Uprising

9:15 - Start of the first team (teams start every 3 minutes).

14:30 - The end of the sports part of the meeting.

15:00 - Ceremonial closing of the meeting, announcement of scores and rewarding the winning teams **at** General Jozef Dowbor Musnicki Museum.

Notice: At the end of the meeting delicious military pea soup from the soldier's kitchen will be served. You will be invited to watch Military Gendarmerie Special Unit Show and the Group in Historical Uniforms.

In the evening hours picnic will be held to celebrate the 10 th anniversary of formation of Polish Reservist Association Of Wielkopolska and promotion of Tarnowo Podgorne Community

6. Prizes:

I - III Place - Cups, Medals.

IV - X Place - Diplomas.

Certificates of participation.

Notice: Prizes are awarded on the basis of obtained times - all Contestants from the team must cross the finish line.

7. Safety Conditions:

During the march all the Contestants must be very careful, especially at the routes and places located near the lake. Arbitrary entering the water and using other vehicles than provided by Organizers is strictly forbidden. In case of faint, accidents notify the Organizers calling the number **+48 533 500080** or ambulance service 999 or 112.

In no case teams shall leave any of its Contestants without care.

8. Organizational issues:

a. The Competition will take place in divisions: Men, Women, Foreign Guests, Junior High School and High School Students, University Students, irrespective of weather conditions.

b. Accommodation for Contestants from beyond Poznan at camp conditions - you need to have your own tent. On request, there is a possibility to accommodate in chalets with prior notice.

c. Societies, Families, Survival and Military Groups are invited.

- d. All Contestants start at their own risk and will have no right to ask for any compensation in case of an accidental event.
- e. Objections must be raised in writing at the Organizers Office.
- f. The Organizers provide medical care, drinks and warm meal.
- g. The Organizers are not responsible for any belongings left unattended.
- h. The Contestants are obliged to wear military uniform.
- i. The Organizers reserve themselves the right to construe the detailed regulations of the individual events and introducing changes to them.

9. Entry fee: 30 Euro/ each competitor
